## AMATEUR RADIO LICENSE CLASS

The Filling Station, in partnership with the New Bern Amateur Radio Club and Jones County Emergency Management, will be holding a Ham Radio Licensing Class for the General Class License. It is recommended that students hold a current Technician Class License. The Class is open to all ages and will prepare the students for the FCC Elements 3 exam, General Class.

As with all current FCC Amateur Radio License there is NO Morse Code required. The course covers regulations, operating practices, electronic theory, and safety. The class is FREE but the student should purchase the ARRL Ham Radio License Manual 10th Edition Study Guide for the General Class license.
